Cabbage Patch Christmas Skirt and Top

Supplies G hook Red WW Yarn White Fun Fur Small amount of elastic NOTE: There are different sizes of Cabbage Patch dolls so my advice would be to start your top and try it on your cabbage patch doll. You may need to up your hook. There are many different options that you can do with this. You could join your top in the round right after you make your armholes.

Abbreviations sc=single crochet hdc=half double crochet ch=chain hk=hook FO= fasten off

Join every rnd of the skirt. G hook Ch 40 HDC in 3rd ch from hk and HDC across, Join

Rnd 1-2 Ch2, HDC around, join

Rnd 3 Ch2, HDC in same st, *HDC in next 2, 2 HDC in next st* repeat around, Join

Rnd 4 Ch 2, HDC in next 2 st, * 2 HDC in next st, HDC in next 3 st.* repeat around, Join

Rnd 5 Ch 4, DC in same st, *Ch 1, sk next st, Single V-Stitch in next st (Single V-Stitch DC, Ch 1, DC all in same stitch)* Join

Rnd 6 Ch 4, DC around ch between 1st S V-Stitch of previous rnd, *DC **into** Ch, S V-Stitch in next st* around, Join

Rnd 7 Ch 4, DC around ch between 1st S V-Stitch of previous rnd, *DC in next st, S V-Stitch in next st* around, Join

Rnd 8 (Ruffle) 5 TRC in each stitch around. (OPTION- you can now do SC around if you don't want ruffles)

Cut a piece elastic that goes around your doll Attach yarn to waist of skirt and sc around elastic. Attach fun fur to any TRC, sc, in same st and sc in each TRC around. FO

Top Ch 32 Row 1 Sc in 2nd ch from hk and next 5 chs, 3 sc in next st, corner made, sc in next 2, 3 sc in next. corner made, sc in next 11 st, 3 sc, in next, corner made, sc, in next 2 st, 3 sc in next st, sc to end., ch 1 turn

Row 2 - 4 sc across putting 3 sc in the middle of the corners. Ch 1, turn, at end of row 4 Ch 2

Row 5 hdc in ea st across putting 3 hdc in ea middle st of corners (depending on the size of your doll you could do Row 6 here.) Ch 2, turn

Row 6 hdc across to the 1st middle corner st, *hdc in this st and ch 3, sk all sts to the next middle st and hdc (armhole made)*, hdc across to next middle st and repeat * to * 2 nd armhole made, hdc to the end. Ch 2, turn

Row 7 hdc in ea st and ch across, ch 2 turn,

Row 8 hdc in next st, *hdc decrease next 2 sts together, hdc in next 2 sts* repeat *-* around, ch 2, turn, (OPTION- you do not have to do decreases you can hdc in each st. I wanted it more tapered at the bottom thus the decreases.)

Row 9 hdc in next st, *hdc decrease next 2 sts together, hdc in next st* repeat *-* around. (OPTION same as above) Ch1, turn

Row 10 sc in ea st across FO

Sleeves Make 2 Row 1- 5 Attach yarn to middle ch under arm, *ch 2, hdc around, join* At end of Row 5 FO Row 6 Attach white Fun Fur to any sc and sc around bottom of sleeve. FO

Headband Ch between 32 and 42 depending on the size of your dolls head., hdc in 3rd ch from hk and across all the chs, attach fun fur, ch 1 and turn and sc in ea st across.
