## Kim's Coaster Holder



The coaster holder is made exactly like the coaster without the ruffle.

Materials Cotton or Worsted Yarn "G" Hook

## **Directions**

After completing the coaster you will be working around DC of round 7 to make the sides.

\*NOTE\* if you are making more than 3 or 4 coasters just add more rows before you start decreasing. That way your 'flaps will cover them. Example was done with 3 coasters.

Row 1 Join yarn "around" any DC of round 7. Ch 1, sc in same space as joining. SC around the next 15 DC sts.

Row 2 Turn, ch 1, sc in Back Loops Only of 15 sc.

Row 3 Turn, ch 1, \* place hook thru back loop of next DC and of the free loop from the row below and SC. \* repeat across.

NOTE: make sure to count to make sure you don't miss a stitch. It is very easy to miss one.

Row 4 – 11 Repeat row 3

Row 12 Turn, ch 1, single 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> st together by inserting hook in 1<sup>st</sup> BL and Free loop (FL) below, YO, pull up loop, insert hook in 2<sup>nd</sup> BL and FL below, YO, pull up loop, YO and pull thru all loops on hook, Decrease made. Continue to SC across until the last 2 sts. Decrease last 2 stitches together.

Row 13 Repeat row 3

Alternate rows 12 and 13 until you have 3 stitches left. SC them all together (3 sc decrease. Done exactly like row 12 except you are adding one more stitch.) This makes your point. Ch 35 and fasten off.

Other Side of Coaster

With front of coaster facing you and 1<sup>st</sup> flap down, skip 12 DC's of round 7, from your 1<sup>st</sup> flap. Join with a sl st around next double and repeat rows 1 – 13 for the second side.
