



Easy DishCloth

This dishcloth is so easy to make that it can be done in a couple of hours. It is a quick gift idea for the last minute housewarming gift. It

has an almost scrubber texture to it. It also isn't as bulky as some crocheted dishcloths.

Materials

G hook

Cotton Yarn

Needle for weaving ends

Abbreviations

Ch-----Chain

SC-----Single Crochet

FLO-----Front Loop Only

BLO-----Back Loop Only

Directions

There is no gauge because it is up to you how big or small you want it.

Chain however long you want your dishcloth to be. For this one I chained 30

Row 1 SC in the 2nd chain from hook and in each ch across

Row 2 Ch 1, turn, *SC in the FLO of next stitch, SC in BLO of the next stitch.* repeat across.

NOTE...If your last stitch is in FLO the begin the next row in FLO.
Repeat row 2 until dishcloth is the desired length that you want.

Edging: Any edging can be used. The edging on this dishcloth is simple SC around all sides of dishcloth. Put as much edging on as you like. I have 3 rows of SC on mine but it looked fine with just 1 row also.
