Supplies
Black WW yarn
White WW yarn
E Hook Bodice
F Hook Sleeves
I Hook Skirt
H Hook Apron
Eyes and Hooks
13 - 13 ½ Doll
Abbreviations
ch - chain
sc - single crochet

dc - double crochet sl st - slip stitch hk - hook

Bodice

Options Ch 1 at end of each row. If you do not want the jagged looking edge DO NOT ch 1. Makes the back edges neater.

chain 16

Row 1 SC in 2nd ch from hook and each rem sc across, turn

Row 2 SC in each sc across, turn

Row 3 2 sc in each sc across, turn

Row 4-5 SC in each sc across, turn

Row 6 SC in first 5 sc, 2 sc in each of next 20 sc, sc in last 5, turn

Row 7 SC in first 6 sc, ch 4 skip next 10 sc, armhole made, sc in next 18 sc, ch 4, skip next 10 sc armhole made, sc in last 6 sc, turn

Row 8 SC in each sc and ch across, turn

Row 9-10 SC in each sc across, turn

Row 11 SC in first 9 sc, *decrease next 2 sc together (to decrease , draw up a lp in each of next 2 sc- 3 lps now on hook, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook) repeat * 9 more times, sc in last 9 sc, turn

Row 12-13 SC in each sc across turn

Row 14 SC in first 2 sc, * decrease over next 2 sc, sc in next 5; repeat from * twice more, decrease over next 2 sc, sc in last 3 sc, turn (NOTE: depending on your doll you may want to do this row one more time if breast area is too big)

Row 15 SC in each sc across, turn

Row 16 SC in first 2 sc,* decrease over next 2 sc, sc in next 4 sc; repeat from * twice more, decrease over next 2 sc, sc in last 2 sc, turn

Row 17- sc across

Skirt Use size I hook

Chain 2 at beginning of each row.

Row 18 2 DC in each st around

Row 19 *2 DC in next st and 1 dc in next* join...you will now be working in rounds. Join each round.

Rnd 20 * 1 DC in next 2 st and 2 DC in next* Repeat

Rnd 21 DC in each st around

Rnd 22 *1 DC in next 3 st and 2 dc in next* repeat around

Rnd 23 DC in each st around

Rnd 24 *1 DC in next 4 st and 2 dc in next * repeat around

Rnd 25 DC in each st around

Rnd 26 *1 DC in next 5 st and 2 dc in next * repeat around

Rnd 27 *1 DC in next 6 st and 2 dc in next * repeat around

Rnd 28 *1 DC in next 7 st and 2 dc in next * repeat around

Rnd 29 *1 DC in next 8 st and 2 dc in next * repeat around

Rnd 30 *1 DC in next 9 st and 2 dc in next * repeat around

Rnd 31 Ch1 sc in each st around - Fasten Off

Apron

H Hook

Row 1 Ch 14, sc in 2nd ch and each ch across, turn

Row 2

Row 3 Ch2, 2dc in each st across, turn

Row 4 Dc in same sp, * ch1, sk next st, dc, ch1, dc in next st, V-st made. * repeat across

Row 5 Ch 3, * V-st in ch 1 sp BETWEEN, V-sts of previous row, Ch1, * across

Row 6 Ch 3, dc in same sp, * Ch 1, V-st, in ch 1 sp of v-st from previous row * repeat

Row 7 Ch 3, Dc in each st and space across

Row 8 Ch 3 dc in each st across

Row 9 Ch 3, dc in same sp, * 1 dc in next st, 2 dc in next * repeat across

Row 10 Ch 3, dc across and Fasten Off

Ties

Join yarn to corner of top of apron, ch20 FO, repeat for other side.

Undies

Row 1 Ch 13, sc in 2^{nd} ch from hook and in each ch across, ch 1, turn (Ch 1 and turn at end of each row)

Row 2-4 Sc across

Row 5 - 6 sl st in 1st sc, sc across to last sc, leave that last st unworked, turn

Row 7 - 10 sc across

Row 11 - Repeat row 5

Row 12-16 Repeat row 7

Row 17-23 2 sc in 1^{st} st, sc to last st, 2 sc in last st.

Row 24-25 Sc across, Fasten Off

Ties

Join yarn to 1 corner of front, ch 20, Fasten Off. Repeat for other front. Run chain into top corner st of each back corner. Put on doll and wrap ties around and tie.

Another Option

Join yarn and ch 10 to all 4 corners and have ties on all 4 corners and then put on doll and tie on the doll.

Bandanna

Row 1 Ch 16 and sc in 2nd ch from hook and sc arcoss.

Row 2-6 Sc across

Row 7 Sc dec. 1^{st} and 2^{nd} st together, sc to last 2 st and dec together

Row 8 Repeat row 7 until 2 sts remain and decrease them together

Sc along ends of row. When at top corner ch 20, sl st back down ch and sl st across top of bandanna to other corner, ch 20, sl st back down ch and sc along ends of rows to point and fasten off
