

Pink Girly Sweater Vest

Please read through the abbreviations before starting this pattern!
Fits 2 - 3 toddler...Big sweater so Shirt can be worn underneath.
Smaller hook makes smaller vest

Supplies

1 skein Bernat Baby Coordinates Sweet Pink

N hook

J hook for ribbing

Abbreviations

SC=single crochet

DC=double crochet

TRC=triple crochet

Ch=chain

St=stitch(es)

Hk=hook

FP=front post (dc)

BP=back Post (dc)

FO=fasten off

NOTE: Chain 2 in stead of 3 at beginning of rows if desired.

Directions

Ch 42

Row 1 Dc in 4th ch from hk and next 4 chs, 3 dc in next ch, corner made, dc in next 6 chs, 3 dc in next ch, corner made, dc in next 12, 3 dc in next ch, corner made, dc in next 6 chs, 3 dc in next, corner made, dc to end. Ch 3 (or ch2) and turn (this will be done every row or round throughout.)

Row 2 – 4 Dc in each st putting 3 dc in 'center' of each corner. At end of row 4 join contrasting yarn in last stitch, with 2 loops on your hk join yarn and ch 3 and turn

Row 5-7 Dc in each st putting 3 dc in 'center' of each corner.

Row 8 Dc to middle st of corner, * dc in corner, ch 4, dc in middle of next corner, armhole made,* dc to next corner, repeat * to * dc to end of row. Join Now working in Rnds. Join each round.

Rnd 9 Dc in each Dc and ch around.

Rnd 10 - 18 Dc in ea st around.

Rnd 19 Change to J hk and Dc in st around.

Rnd 20 (Ribbing)*FPDC around next st BPDC around next st.* Repeat between *-* FO

Collar

Row 1 Attach yarn to left front of neck. V is in Front using the J hk and Sc around neck edge. (you are working in the other side of the foundation ch.) 3 sc go in corners.

Row 2 turn, sl st in next st, sc in next, hdc in next, dc in next, trc in around to the last 4 sts, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st, sl st in next st. turn

Row 3 repeat row 2. You will be sl in sl sts, sc in sc, hdc in hdc, dc in dc and trc in trc.

Row 4 turn and sc in ea st, at end of collar continue down the side of v and up the other side and join to 1st sc of collar and FO.

Sleeves

Optional! You don't have to do anything. I attached under the arm and sc around.

Tie down the front. OPTIONAL Since I was using it as a V neck I didn't particularly like the line down the front where I joined so I chained a chain of 100 and weaved it in like shoe laces starting at the next to last row of ribbing and then tied in a bow at the top. Look at picture below for placement.
