Pink Penny

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Materials

Redheart Baby Pink 3 ply Sport yarn 2.5 oz

Ribbon eyelash yarn (I do not know exactly what kind of yarn this was as it was given to me without the wrapper.

Amount 1 ball)

13" doll

Eyes and Hooks

E Crochet Hook

F Crochet Hook

G Crochet Hook

Stitches used

Chain (ch)

Single Crochet (SC)

Double Crochet (DC)

Slip Stitch (SL ST)

Picot (ch 3, sc in next stitch)

Cross Stitch (Cr St)

Directions

With E hook, Ch 26 (bodice fits snuggly)

Row 1 SC in 2^{nd} ch from hook. sc in next 4 chains, 3 sc in next, corner made, sc in next 3 chains, 3 sc in next, 2^{nd} corner made, sc in next 6 chains, 3 sc in next, 3^{rd} cornet made, sc in next 3 chains, 3 sc in next, 4^{th} corner made, sc to the end.

Row 2 turn, ch 1 (for nicer edge do not ch 1) sc in each sc with 3 sc in each middle sc of each corner. You may mark the middle sc of each corner with a piece of yarn to make it easier.

Row 3 Repeat row 2

Row 4 turn, sc to middle of sc of 1^{st} corner, ch 7, sc in middle of sc of next corner, armhole made, sc to middle of next corner, ch 7, sc in middle sc of last corner, armhole made, sc to the end.

Row 5 turn, sc in each sc and ch across

Row 6 - 14 turn and sc in each st across

Row 15 Change to F hook, ch 3, sk 2 sc, dc in next, dc in 2nd skip sc and dc, one cross st made, *ch 1, sk 1 st, dc in next, dc in sk dc * repeat across to last 2 sts. Sk next and dc in last st. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. You are now working in rounds. This row is where your ribbon eyelash will go for your waist tie. Weave yarn in between cr sts, leave long enough tail to tie a nice bow in the back. (option...you may double your eyelash yarn if you desire. I did.)

RND 16 Ch 3, 2 dc in each ch 1 space and each dc around to last st.

1 dc in last st and join to top of ch 3.

RND 17 Ch 3, dc in each dc around, join to top of ch 3.

RND 18 Ch 3 *dc in next dc, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to top of ch 3.

RND 19 - 20 Ch 3, 1 dc in each dc around, join to top of ch 3. End of round 20 fasten off. (Optional...if you want the dress a little long continue round 20 to desired length.)

Bottom Trim

With your Eyelash Ribbon, or whatever you are using for your bottom trim, and G hook attach yarn in back and sc in joining st. *ch 3 loosely (if using eyelash yarn), sk next st and sc in next* repeat around, join and fasten off.

Collar

With F hook

Row 1 With back facing you, attach yarn to 1^{st} st on back left of foundation chain. Sc in same space as joining, sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc in next corner (1^{st} corner) sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc in next corner (2^{nd} corner), sc in next 5 sts, 3 sc in next corner (3^{rd} corner), sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc in next corner (last corner) sc to end.

Row 2 Turn, * ch 3, slst in 2^{nd} ch from hook, sc in next st * (picot made) repeat from * to * across. Fasten Off.

Sew eyes and hooks to the back of the dress, put her hat on and drape her boa around her and she is ready to go out on the town.

Boa

With G hook ch 36 loosely

Row 1 Sc in 2nd ch from hook and sc across

Row 2-3 turn ch 1 sc across. End of row 3 Fasten off and weave in ends.

Hat

With G Hook and pink yarn ch 5 and sl st to form ring. You will be joining each round with a sl st in top of ch 3 unless otherwise stated.

RND 1 Ch 3 Make 19 dc in ring (do not count ch 3)

RND 2 Ch 3 2 dc in each dc around

RND 3 Ch 3 dc in each dc around

RND 4 Ch 3 BLO (back loop only this round) dc in each dc around. This round is where your ribbon eyelash yarn will weave thru.

RND 5 Ch 3 2 dc in each dc around

RND 6 Ch 1 sc in each dc around. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Weave your ribbon eyelash yarn in and out of round 4. Across 2 stitches and under 2 stitches.



This pattern could be adjusted very easily for one of those fashion dolls from Wal-Mart in the craft section. Once you get started on making dolls you will be amazed at how you can become hooked on doing dolls.
