

Santa Bandana

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Materials

Small amount of red yarn
in Worsted Weight.

Small amount of white fun
fur

Size K hook

Guage not important

Abbreviations Used

Ch – Chain

Sl St - Slip Stitch

DC – Double Crochet

FO – Fasten Off

SP – Space

Ch 3, sl st to form ring

Row 1 Ch 3, (ch 3 is counting at 1 dc) 2 dc, Ch1,
3 dc, turn

Row 2 Ch 3, dc in same st or very first dc crochet
in each dc to Ch1 sp,

(3DC, Ch1, 3DC) dc in each dc to end. Turn

Row 3-12 Repeat row 2. (Option – for longer
bandana keep repeating this row

until desired length)

At end of row 12 DO NOT FO. * Ch 35, (or more for longer ties) Sl St in 2nd Ch
from hook and every chain down to 1st chain. Sl St to first stitch, * sl st around
entire bandana until you get to the other side and repeat *-* FO and Weave in
ends.

White trim.

Attach fun fur to right corner of top of bandana. Point of bandana will be facing
you.

Row 1 Ch 3, Dc AROUND sc post. Dc around each sc post, turn

Row 2 Ch 3, Dc around sc post again going across front again. You will be
working now with point pointed away from you. **(Row 2 is optional. You can
stop after row 1 if you desire.)**

Tassle

I wrapped the yarn around 3 fingers about 15 times and then tied it off and
sewed it to the point.
