

# *Airy Elegant Shrug, Skirt and Scrunchie*

Please read through the abbreviations before starting this pattern! Choose your option on page 3 before you start your sweater.

Fits 2 - 3 toddler...Big sweater so Shirt can be worn underneath. I use the N hk because my granddaughter's skin is sensitive and I like the way it makes up with this hook and she can wear a shirt underneath. For smaller size use smaller hk.

## Supplies

6 oz of Red Heart Super Sport Yarn Navy 3 ply

N hook for Shrug

H hook for Skirt

1 button

NOTE: Chain 2 in stead of 3 at beginning of rows if desired.

## Abbreviations

hk = hook

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

sc = single crochet

st = stitch/es

flo = front loops only

blo = back loops only

fo = fasten off

## Gauge

6 DC= 2 inches or 5 cm for skirt only

2 rows = 2 inches or 2.5 cm (approx)

## Directions

In solid color Ch 42

Row 1 Dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hk and next 4 chs, 3 dc in next ch, corner made, dc in next 6 chs, 3 dc in next ch, corner made, dc in next 12, 3 dc in next ch, corner made, dc in next 6 chs, 3 dc in next, corner made, dc to end. Ch 3 and turn ( this will be done every row or round throughout.)

Row 2 – 4 Dc in each st putting 3 dc in 'center' of each corner. At end of row 4 join contrasting yarn in last stitch, with 2 loops on your hk join yarn and ch 3 and turn

Row 5-7 Dc in each st putting 3 dc in 'center' of each corner.

Row 8 Dc to middle st of corner, \* dc in corner, ch 4, dc in middle of next corner, armhole made,\* dc to next corner, repeat \* to \* dc to end of row.

Row 9 Dc in each st and chain across

Row 10-13 Dc in each st across at end of 13 ch 1 turn (If you want it shorter don't put all 13 rows on stop where you want it)

Row 14 sc in 1st st, \*3 dc in next st, sk st, sc in next,\* repeat \* to \* Fasten Off

## Sleeves

(You may need more or less rnds depending on your childs arm length)

Rnd 1 join to center st under arm, ch 3 and dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 2- 11 dc in each st around. At end of row 11 ch 1

Rnd 12 sc in 1st st, \*3 dc in next st, sk st, sc in next,\* repeat \* to \* Fasten Off

## Collar

Starting at the left side at the bottom attach yarn and ch 1, 2 sc in same st, sc along the side till you reach the collar, sc in 1st st, (other loop of beg ch) **\*\*NOTE\*\* at this point you can sc all the way across if desired,** \*3 dc in next st, sk next st, sc in next,\* repeat across collar, at end of collar, 2 sc in end and then sc down the other side. At the end put 2 sc and join to bottom with sl st.

Attach a button at the top on the left side and you are done. The button will fit in between any stitch.

Weave in all ends!

## Skirt

H hk ch 81

Row 1 sc in 2nd ch from hk and every ch across. join with sl st to 1st sc. You will now be working in rnds. Join each rnd.

Rnd 2 - 5 ch 2 and hdc in ea st across

Rnd 6 ch 2, hdc in same st, \*hdc in next, 2 hdc in next\*, repeat around

Rnd 7 repeat rnd 2

**Rnd 8** ch 2, \*hdc in blo of next st, hdc in flo of next st.\* repeat around

**Rnd 9** ch 2, you will put a dc in the front loops of the above row and dc in through both loops in other sts like usual.

Rnd 10-19 Dc in ea st around

Rnd 21 ch1, sc in same st, \*3 dc in next st, sk next st, sc in next\* repeat around and join and FO

## Top of the skirt

Attach yarn with sc to where you joined in rnd 2. SC all around, Join.

Cut elastic to fit the child and sew the ends together. SC around the elastic and into sc of previous rnd just done.

### Belt Loops

Place 6 beltloops evenly spaced around the skirt. i put 2 in the front, one on each side and 2 in the back.

Attach yarn to Sc and ch 3 and sl st to the st right under in the row under the elastic. FO weave in I know it's a lot of attaching and weaving but the outcome I thought was worth it.

### Belt

Chain a chain long enough to go around your child and tie in a bow.



### Scrunchie

Big pony holder

H hook

small amount of yarn

sc around the pony holder, mine had 36, ( i could have put more around but needed the give)

Sl st to 1st sc, \*3dc in next st, sk next st, sc in next\* around and join to 1st sc and FO weave in ends.
