

# Snowman Sweater

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Please read through the abbreviations and special stitches before starting this pattern!

## Supplies

1 skein Navy Red Heart

1 skein of Sh. Dusk Variegated

N hook

I hook for ribbing

3 buttons

Snowman hooks---G and E

NOTE: Chain 2 at beginning of rows if desired.

## Abbreviations

hk = hook

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

sc = single crochet

st = stitch/es

fpc = front post double crochet

bpc = back post double crochet

dec = decrease

fphdc = front post half double crochet

bphdc = back post half double crochet

yo = yarn over

fo = fasten off

## Gauge

6 DC = 2 inches or 5 cm

2 rows = 2 inches or 2.5 cm (approx)

## Special Stitches

Here is an example for you to look at if needed. Click [here](#).

BPHDC – YO insert hook from the back to the front and back to the backside of the of desired stitch, yo and pull up a loop (3 loops on your hook) yo and pull through all loops. BPHDC made.

FPHDC Done exactly like BPHDC except you insert your hook from the front to the back and back to the front.

## Directions

Ch 42

Row 1 Dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hk and next 4 chs, 3 dc in next ch, corner made, dc in next 6 chs, 3 dc in next ch, corner made, dc in next 12, 3 dc in next ch, corner made, dc in next 6 chs, 3 dc in next, corner made, dc to end. Ch 3 and turn ( this will be done every row or round throughout.)

Row 2 – 7 Dc in each st putting 3 dc in 'center' of each corner.

Row 8 Dc to middle st of corner, \* dc in corner, ch 4, dc in middle of next corner, armhole made,\* dc to next corner, repeat \* to \* dc to end of row.

Row 9 Dc in each st and ch across join. You will now be working in rounds.

Rnd 1 - 18 Dc in each st around join, ch 3. At end of rnd 18 Fasten Off and join new color.

Rnd 19 -ribbing – Changing to your I hook Dc in each st around.  
(OPTION- if you want 2 rows of ribbing then FPDC in next st and BPDC in next around)

Rnd 20 – ribbing – Ch3 FPDC in next st and BPDC in next around and Fasten Off.

## Sleeves

Rnd 1 join navy to center st under arm, ch 3 and dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 2-8 dc in each st around.

Rnd 9 (decrease round) ch 3 dc decrease in every stitch around.

Rnd 10 ch3, dc in next, dc decrease in next, around. Fasten Off

Rnd 11 join variegated, change to I hook, ch3, dc in each st around.

Rnd 12 ch 3, FPDC in next st, BPDC in next around.

Fasten off.

Repeat for next sleeve.

Collar

Row 1 attach variegated and ch 2, hdc in each st around.

Row 2 ch 2, turn and FPHDC in next st, BPHDC in next around.

Fasten off

Back

Attach variegated to bottom of right back and single crochet in each st to top, ch 1 turn, sc back down to beginning, (evenly space buttonholes), ch 1 sc in next, ch 1 sc in next, buttonhole made, continue in this manner to the top ending with a buttonhole. Fasten off

Attach variegated to bottom of left back, ch 1 sc all the way up to the top, turn, ch1 sc, in each st back down and repeat one more time going up and fasten off. Weave in ends!

## Snowman

G hook

join every round

Head

Ch 3 slip to form circle

10 sc in ring

ch1 sc in same space, 2dc in each st around

ch1 sc in next and 2 in next around fo

## Body

ch 3 slip to form circle

10 sc in ring

ch1 sc in same space, 2dc in each st around

ch1 sc in next and 2 in next around

ch1 sc in each st around

ch1 2 sc in each stitch around

fo

## Arms (make 2)

e hook

ch 10 sl st in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in next 2

ch 4 and sl st in next 3 and sl st in next st on main ch and sl st around and up the other side of original ch in first 4 chs, ch 4 and sl st back down and sl st in next st of original ch and FO

## Hat

e hook

ch 9 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hk and across

ch1, turn, sc across

ch1, turn, sc across

ch1, turn, sc across

ch1, turn, sc decrease first 2 stitches together and sc across to last 2 st and sc decrease them together.

Repeat last row until you have one st remaining. I stopped when I had 3 stitches and decreased all 3 together.

FO

## Scarf

cut 1 piece of yarn about 24 inches, take one end and wrap around your index and middle fingers about 5 times loop the yarn thru the loops on your fingers then with your e hook start chaining. Ch 30 and wrap remaining yarn around your fingers again and pull tail through and secure with a knot. Cut the loops for the fringe.

Repeat wrapping of yarn for a tassel of the hat if desired
