

Toddler Regular Sized Catchall Bib

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Materials

small amount of contrasting yarn and small ball of main color yarn.
I have no idea how much because I was using up odds and ends.

You of course can make all one color.

I hook

ABBREVIATIONS

SC= single crochet

HDC= half double crochet

FO= fasten off

CH= chain

ST= stitch

EA= each

TOG= together

row 1 ch 25 sc in 2nd ch from hook and ea ch across, ch 1 turn

row 2-3 2 sc in first st and sc in ea st across to last st, 2 sc in

last st ch 1 and turn

row 4-11 sc in ea st across, ch 1 turn

row 12-24 hdc in ea st across, ch1 turn

row 25 hdc in first 8 sts, ch1, turn

row 26 hdc decrease over 1st 2 sts, hdc to end, ch 1, turn **(NOTE your decreases will be on the inside, neckedge. I am making a note about this because I was watching TV and wasn't paying attention and was just decreasing all over the place.)**

row 27 hdc to last 2 st, hdc decrease last 2 sts tog, ch 1, turn

row 28 repeat row 26

row 29-31 hdc in ea st across, ch 1, turn

row 32 2 hdc in 1st st **(NOTE increase will be on the inside neckedge)** hdc ea st across, ch 1, turn

row 33 hdc to last st and hdc increase, ch 1, turn

row 34 repeat row 32

row 35 hsc in ea st across FO

Reattach yarn to outside st of row 25 repeat row 25-35 for otherside.

Catchall

Repeat rows 1-11 of bib

When done line it up with the bib using sc attach to bib continue around with sc, putting 3sc in corners...when you get to the corner of neck edge put 2 sc in corner and then ch 40 and sl st back down the ch put 3rd sc in corner (Tie made) and continue with sc around to next side of neck edge and repeat for next tie. continue sc around bib. FO weave in ends!
