

# Wild Sweater

Please read through the abbreviations before starting this pattern! Choose your option on the last page before you start your sweater.

Fits 2 - 3 toddler...Big sweater so Shirt can be worn underneath.

## Supplies

1 skein Shocking Pink

1 skein of Bon Bon Print Variegated and little of another.

N hook

K hook for ribbing

2 Drawstring Stoppers

NOTE: Chain 2 in stead of 3 at beginning of rows if desired.

## Abbreviations

CC Concrasting Color

hk = hook

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

sc = single crochet

st = stitch/es

dec = decrease

yo = yarn over

fo = fasten off

## Gauge

6 DC= 2 inches or 5 cm

2 rows = 2 inches or 2.5 cm (approx)

## Directions

In solid color Ch 42

Row 1 Dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hk and next 4 chs, 3 dc in next ch, corner made, dc in next 6 chs, 3 dc in next ch, corner made, dc in next 12, 3 dc in next ch, corner made, dc in next 6 chs, 3 dc in next, corner made, dc to end. Ch 3 and turn ( this will be done every row or round throughout.)

Row 2 – 4 Dc in each st putting 3 dc in 'center' of each corner. At end of row 4 join contrasting yarn in last stitch, with 2 loops on your hk join yarn and ch 3 and turn

Row 5-7 Dc in each st putting 3 dc in 'center' of each corner.

Row 8 Dc to middle st of corner, \* dc in corner, ch 4, dc in middle of next corner, armhole made,\* dc to next corner, repeat \* to \* dc to end of row.

Row 9 Dc in each st and ch across join. You will now be working in rounds.

Rnd 1 - 11 Dc in each st around join, ch 3. At end of rnd 11 Fasten Off and join new color. (If doing stripes change after 4 or 5 rnds to next color)

Rnd 12 Changing to your K hook Sc in each st around.

Rnd 13 Ch1 and Backwards SC around, (Backwards SC, SC in next st to the RIGHT) and Fasten Off.

## Sleeves

Rnd 1 join Contrasting color to center st under arm, ch 3 and dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 2-9 dc in each st around.

Rnd 10 (decrease round) ch 3 dc decrease in every stitch around.

Rnd 11 ch3, dc, around. Fasten Off

Rnd 12 join solid, change to K hook, ch1, sc in each st around.

Rnd 13 ch 1, Sc around.

Fasten off.

Repeat for next sleeve.

### Collar

Row 1 Attach CC yarn to left front of neck edge and SC in each st around and down and around the V. Sl st to 1st sc made, Ch2 and turn

Row 2 Going back down the V sl st in next st, \*sc in next 2 sc, ch2, sl st in next\* around to right side of sweater. (Ch 2 spaces is where your tie is going to go in)

Fasten off

Tie, with variegated ch 80 and fasten off. Starting at the bottom of the V lace the tie through like lacing shoe laces.

### Options,

1. you can put the drawstring stoppers like in the sweater above at the end of your tie.
2. you can forget the tie all together and Sc 3 or 4 in between your ch 2's in row 2 of the collar and put 3 or 4 buttons down and have it button in the front or the back.

Weave in ends!
